Oxford Botanic Garden was founded in 1621. It is Britain's oldest botanic garden and dedicated to promoting the scientific wonder of plants. It is home to over 8,000 species. Harcourt Arboretum stems from the ornamental pinetum designed by Gilpin in 1830s. The 130 acres site is home to many rare and threatened trees, some extinct in the wild. This important conservation area has beautiful meadows, and woodland walks.
